ACEC Celebrates Accomplishments and the Future of Engineering



The American Council of Engineering Companies of Minnesota held its 2024 Annual Meeting at the Bullard Rainforest Auditorium at Como Zoo in St. Paul on May 9, with more than 100 in attendance from 30 firms. There was a lot to celebrate, as in addition to highlighting the many accomplishments of the organization over the last year, ACEC Minnesota bestowed the Tom Roche Lifetime Achievement Award, the Firm of the Year Award, and the Emerging Leader Award.



Mankato-based Bolton & Menk, celebrating its 75th anniversary this year, took home the Firm of the Year award.



Gene Sieve, PE, of Burns & McDonnell, 2018 winner of the Tom Roche Lifetime Achievement Award presented the same honor to Ed Studniski, PE, of Ayres Associates, who is familiar to many ACEC Minnesota members, given his long association with the organization.

The 2024 recipient of the Emerging Leader Award was Brad Wodash, PE, a structural engineer at Kimley-Horn, who has worked at the company since 2015. Wodash serves on the ACEC Minnesota Workforce Development Committee, with heavy involvement in recruitment efforts, and is involved with the Engineering Education Foundation of America, including outreach to students at elementary schools in the Twin Cities.

Minnesota Spring Legislative Session Update: Labor Provisions

The 2024 legislative session came to a rather chaotic close on May 20, 2024. In the final hours of the session there were major bills that were combined together into 1400+ page omnibus bills that passed with minutes to spare. We have reviewed the final bills and there were a number of labor provisions that may impact you and your company. The major labor provisions that passed are included in the list below. If you are interested in learning more about what else passed, please review the ACEC/MN Legislative Summary prepared by our lobbyists at Poul Haas.

Minimum Wage Carve Out—Effective January 1, 2025

- Minnesota employees entitled to a single minimum wage.
- Lower tier is eliminated for employees at small business, employees under 18 and foreign workers on J visas (hospitality industry).
- Wages will raise by more than \$2 an hour when they mirror the state's minimum wage for large employers - \$10.85 per hour and will rise with inflation.
- Tips cannot be counted toward the minimum wage.
- Increases the cap on how much the state minimum wage can rise with inflation from 2.5% to 5% (larger increases when there is high inflation).
- DID NOT PASS: separate proposal to eliminate subminimum wage for disabled workers.

Salary Range Posting—Effective January 1, 2025

- Requires employers who employ more than 30 employees to include salary ranges in job postings
- Must include a general description of benefits and other compensation
- If you do not have a salary range you must post a fixed pay rate

Paid Family Medical Leave Fix Bill—Effective Date--Various

- Allows for retroactive payments for people making medical claims.
- Allows for immediate payments for new mothers.
- Increases the payroll tax from .7% to .88%.
- Creates a comprehensive appeals process which may be utilized by employers and employees.
- Allows employers to opt out of the State Paid Leave program if they have their own private plan.
- Reminder: Starting in July, most employers will be able to submit quarterly wage detail reports to the Paid Leave program.

Minnesota Spring Legislative Session Update: Labor Provisions

Earned Sick and Safe Time Provisions—Effective May 25, 2024

- Changes how employers must report available and used EEST hours
- Requires ESST to be paid at the employee’s “base rate”
- EEST includes workers “anticipated” to work 80+ hours/year in Minnesota.
- Allows an employer to require documentation after three consecutive scheduled absences using ESST.
- Allows employees to use ESST to attend funeral/memorial or handle related financial and legal matters after a family members death.
- Employers not required to allow ESST use in less than 15-minute increments and cannot require use in more than four-hour increments.

Employee Misclassification—Effective July 1, 2024

- Employers face harsher penalties--\$10,000 for each violation.
- Creates penalties for classifying employees as independent contractors to avoid paying minimum wages, overtime and unemployment insurance and workers’ compensation.
- Allows all workers – not just construction workers – to sue their employers for misclassification.
- Allows the Minnesota Department of Labor to issue stop work orders where violations occur.

Shadow Non-Competes—Effective July 1, 2024

- Restricts businesses and contractors from entering service contracts that restrict workers’ employment options.

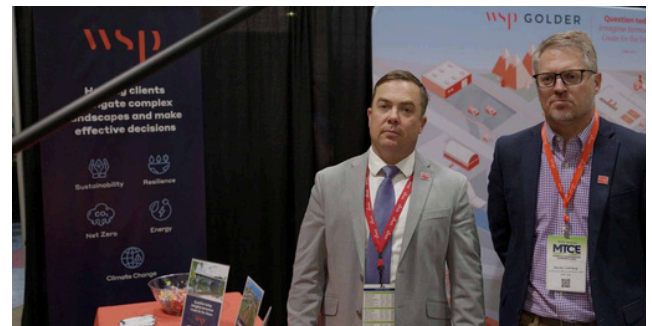


2024 MN Transportation Conference & Expo

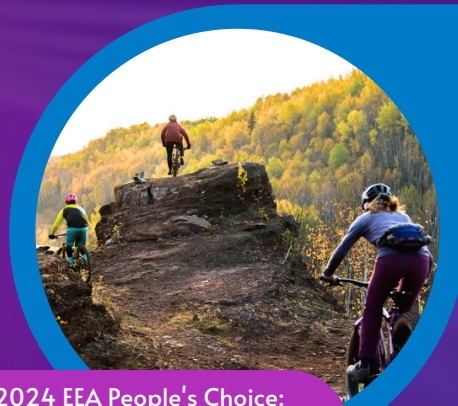

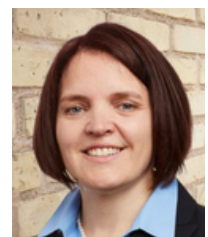

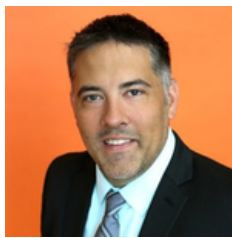
